"Working with Fire, to Fight Fire" By Jaysey Grooms

Eric Smith (Mrs. Linda's Smith husband) works for the Arkansas Forestry Commission. He is a Wildland Firefighter who goes wherever the need is greatest as determined by the Department of Agriculture.

He has traveled all over the country fighting wildfires when circumstances require "all hands-on deck" to combat dangerous fire situations. With the devastating fires in Southern California, I spoke to him about his personal experience fighting wildfires.

He enjoys working outdoors, working with fires, and trying to figure out how fires work; so, while this is his passion, it is also very dangerous! While "Working with fire to fight fire" sounds strange, he learned how to do exactly that.

There is danger in the unknown: What is going on with the fires? What is causing them to burn? What is the fire fuel source and how to stop it. He said, "Once you can figure out the source, then you can work on stopping it."

In 2007, while working as a Dozer Boss in a Montana wildfire, he was injured while the putting in the fire lines. As the dozer was pushing several pine trees down, the top of one of the trees came down and hit him in the mid-section causing him to fall backwards. This incident caused him to spend six hours in the emergency room.

Fighting fires is not only physically taxing, but emotionally, also. In 2013, it hit him hard as he and his friends were working on the fires in extremely volatile conditions. Knowing that his friends and coworkers might get hurt or even killed is one of the most difficult realities of the job.

As a firefighter, he knows the risk that he might get hurt or even killed, but he does this type of work anyway. Although they may never meet those whose property the worked to protect, they continue to answer the calls.

Sometimes, after a traumatic event, some people realize they are not suited for this job. Counseling is available as needed.

Smith continues to do this type of work knowing that he can't save everything, but it is satisfying knowing you helped saved lives and property.

I asked him, "Do you consider yourself a hero?" He answered, "I think everyone is a hero to some extent, but I don't consider myself one just because of the job I have chosen to do."

CEO Murder and Manhunt By Breanna Gibson

Brian Thompson, the CEO of the American health insurance company, UnitedHealthcare, was shot and killed in Manhattan, New York City, on December 4, 2024. The shooting occurred early in the morning outside the New York Hilton Midtown. Thompson was in the city to attend an annual investors' meeting for UnitedHealth Group, the parent company of UnitedHealthcare.

The shooter remained unidentified for days as he consistently wore a facemask and hoodie in every image as his steps were followed on security cameras located throughout NYC. Finally, as days turned to weeks, he let his guard down. He revealed his face to a girl and suddenly, he created a fan following from his surprisingly good looks.

Withing days of his image being released to the public, an alert employee at a Pennsylvania McDonald's called in the tip, leadiong investigators his location where he was arrested.

For several days, law enforcement from multiple agencies conducted a manhunt for this unknown shooter who was later identified as Luigi Mangione.

Prior to his death, Thompson faced criticism for the company's rejection of insurance claims causing lots of disruption. His family reported that he had received death threats in the past. This time someone followed through and executed Brian Thompson.

Mangione, was found in Altoona, Pennsylvania, is accused of first degree murder, murder in furtherance of terrorism, criminal possession of a weapon and stalking.

His next court date is mid-February.
