## Class Procedures

- Daily Routine
  - a. Get out materials (book, calculator, assignments that are due, pencil, paper, etc.)
  - b. Check for missing assignments/absent work
  - c. Check the board for daily instructions.
    - i. Instructions, bellwork, objectives, and the date will be written on the board underneath "Bellwork"
  - d. Bellwork
    - i. This is to be done as soon as you walk into the room, not when the bell rings. VVhen I walk in at the bell, you should be working on bellwork

How our class operates: Continued....

- f. Pick up trash on and around your desk at the end of class. g. Return your calculator to the case before you leave the room.
- 2. When turning in assignments, make sure you put them in the correct class period's drawer at the back of the room.

## Homework

- Generally two homework assignments per week

  - Also, two SAVVAS assignments each week. Those will be assigned on Mondays and will be due at 3pm on Friday. You will have 5 days to complete them...NO EXCEPTIONS!

# Classroom Library

- You may check out books from my classroom library.
   Books can only be checked out one at a time and for two weeks at a time.
- When checking out books, I have a folder that you will use to write the book's information, check in/out dates, and your name. This is a way for me to keep track of what books are checked out and who has them.
- Please be respectful and take care of my books. They are not easily replaceable.

## Leaving the Room

# Electronic Policy

- In accordance with the "Bell to Bell, No Cell Act" (SB142/Act 122), possession and use of any personal electronic device interferes with a positive, orderly school environment, does not respect the rights of others, and is strictly prohibited. During the school day, all student personal electronic devices must be turned off and placed in a secure location out of access to students. Students will not be allowed to access any personal electronic devices for the entire school day, from the first bell to the last.
- Discipline actions include the following:
- 1st offense Detention; parent must pick up the phone.
- 2nd offense One day in ISS; parent must pick up phone.
- 3rd offense Three days in ISS; parent must pick up phone; student must turn in personal electronic devices to the building office daily for the remainder of the semester.
- 4th and subsequent offenses 3 days out-of-school suspension; parent must pick up phone; student must turn in personal electronic devices to the building office daily for the remainder of the school year.
