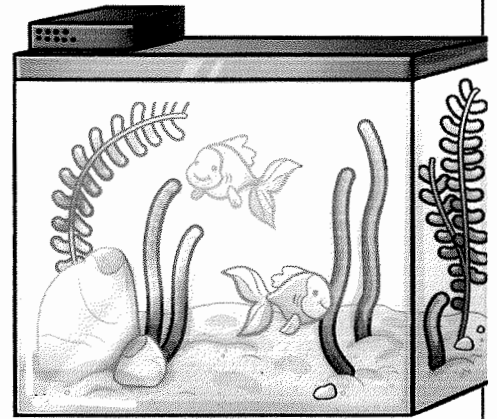

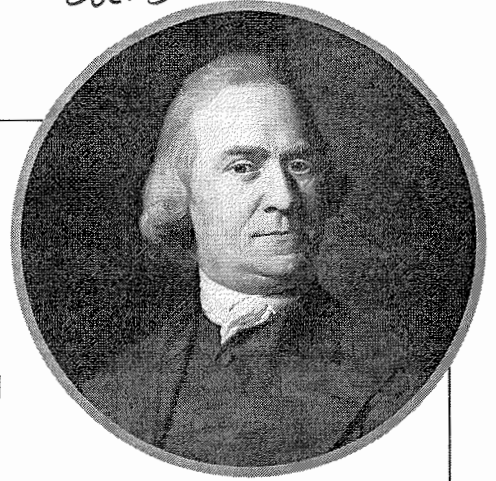

Samuel Adams

Samuel Adams (1722 – 1803) was one of the Founding Fathers of the United States. He was a second cousin to fellow Founding Father, John Adams.

Samuel Adams was born in Boston, Massachusetts. He was a leader of the American Revolution and encouraged colonists to resist British rule. He especially opposed the British taxing colonists.

Adams helped plan the Boston Tea Party of 1773. This was a protest of the British tax on tea. American colonists dumped 342 chests of tea into Boston Harbor.

Adams was a member of the Continental Congress. In 1776, he signed the Declaration of Independence. He also helped write the Articles of Confederation, the first constitution of the United States. He later served as governor of Massachusetts.

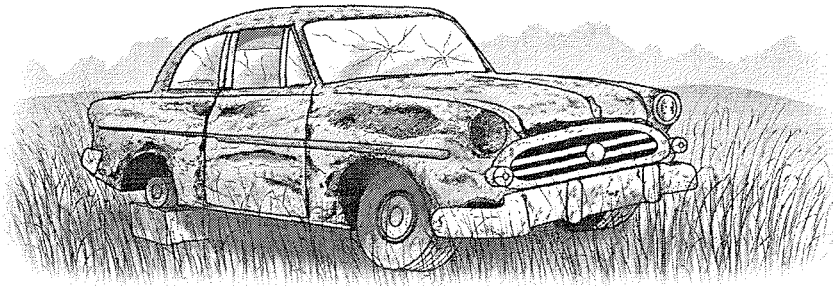

Why does metal rust?

You know what rusty metal looks like, but have you ever wondered why you've never seen rust on a piece of wood or plastic? Rust is a sign of **corrosion**, which occurs when metal is exposed to air and moisture. Metal that is rusted may be crumbly, have holes in it, or have rough, reddish-brown patches on it.

Corrosion in metals arises from a **chemical reaction**, which is a process in which substances react to form new substances. A chemical reaction is different from a physical change. When you scratch metal, the chemical makeup of metal stays the same, even if its appearance changes. But when metal rusts, a chemical reaction takes place between water, oxygen, and iron that changes the metal into a whole new substance.

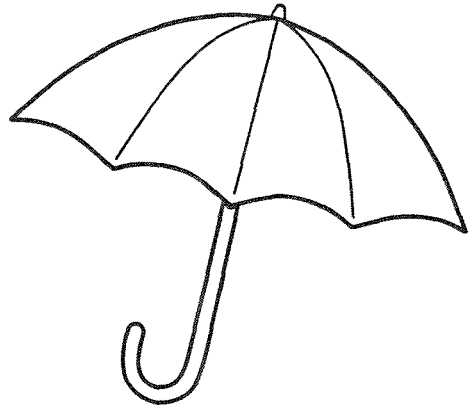

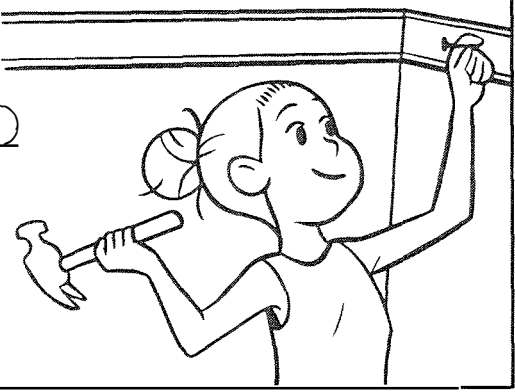
